She/he will assist a post-doc fellow in a project recently funded by the Italian Cystic Fibrosis Research Foundation that aims to define whether new approved CFTR-modulators have an impact on infection in cystic fibrosis lung disease.

The candidate will perform in vitro assays on bacterial and cellular cultures, and in vivo experiments. Laboratory experience working with cell and/or bacterial cultures would be preferable. The ability to handle mice will be considered a plus.
